Background

One Tree is a technology company that provides gift voucher solutions to the hospitality and leisure industry. They work with multiple clients throughout the UK and primarily provide their service through an online web application that allows organisations and their customers to place orders for gift vouchers, make payment online and redeem the vouchers. The application is built using the Codelgniter framework for the back-end with a mixture of Bootstrap and Stencil.js for the front-end.

One Tree is looking for an experienced web application developer to support their sustained growth. The role will involve taking technical leadership of the web application, managing the existing codebase and developing new functionality in-line with best practices. You will be working in a small team alongside the business owners, a part-time development lead and an external consultant who was involved in building the platform originally.

Development tasks will span both front-end and back-end functionality, alongside server administration, using a range of technologies with an overall focus on integrating with the existing codebase and delivering scalable, optimised, accessible and secure code. This is a great opportunity for the right person with real potential within a growing company.

There can be an element of remote work to the role though you need to be able to easily get to the office in Paulton (South of Bristol and Bath) - having your own transport is a bonus. Reachable by bus but easier by car/moped/bike!

- Web components (e.g. React or Stencil)
- Git version control
- Experience integrating with payment processing systems (e.g. Stripe, PayPal)
- Linux server administration

- Strong understanding of web and programming principles, including security and accessibility best practices
- Self-starter with ability to manage your own time and find solutions to problems with little support
- An interest in planning and architecting the right solutions to a problem
- Ability to understand and translate non-technical requirements and ask the right questions
